Engage class members aspire to improve our region because they have deepened their civic commitment and awareness of diverse issues and industries. Through the connections, education, and interests developed by our county's most promising leaders, LPBC creates a lasting impact in our community.

Leadership Palm Beach County (LPBC) is a nonprofit organization that brings together leaders from the public, private and nonprofit sectors to build and steward a vibrant, interconnected community.

Since 1983, our unique programs have prepared more than 2,000 adult and youth leaders for a lifetime commitment to doing public good in Palm Beach County.

LPBC's Engage Program is based on an interactive, 10-month curriculum that provides leadership capacity-building skills framed around countywide issues. Participants meet for one day each month, from September to May and explore program topics such as agriculture, public safety, and healthcare. In addition, each participant will take part in an Engage Forward project that will solve a challenge in our community while learning to collaborate in a group dynamic with fellow classmates and other leaders. #### **Selection Criteria**

LPBC seeks to identify individuals who are most likely to utilize their leadership abilities for the longterm benefit of Palm Beach County. Emphasis is given to those who have demonstrated leadership and community involvement outside of their career, which has long been consistent with graduates' likelihood to continue their involvement with LPBC beyond graduation. Participants will be selected by an anonymous Selection Committee comprised of LPBC alumni. Committee members will award points for each question, and maximum points are listed for each question. References may be checked. This application is only for the Class of 2024 program year. If a candidate is unable to participate after selected, no deferral will be granted. Applicants who wish to apply again are encouraged to do so, and will need to pay the then current application fee.

#### **Leadership Engage Program Time Commitment**

Candidates should only submit an application if certain of their ability to meet the below time commitment.

- Monthly All-Day Leadership Engage Program Session Days
  - One excused absence allowed; additional missed days must be made up the following year, or through a pre-determined and approved Leadership Grow Program day. Missing even one hour will count as an absence.
- Friday-Saturday Mandatory Overnight Opening Retreat
- Orientation and Closing Retreat
- Engage Forward participation and meetings as necessary (Average 3-5 hours per month or about 25 hours total outside of class days, based on prior projects)

#### Class of 2024 Leadership Engage Program Tuition

**Tuition is \$2,500.** 

If you are selected for the class, the full tuition amount is payable by July 14, 2023.

The tuition includes payment for your first year's dues (\$175) as a member of the Leadership Palm Beach County Alumni Association. You are encouraged to solicit financial backing from the employer or organization with whom you work or volunteer, and to pay some portion of the tuition yourself. As we do not believe that tuition should be a barrier to participation, a limited number of partial scholarships are available based on need. Please complete the financial aid section of the application if you are in need of this support.

  - a.1 Application and 2 Letters of Recommendation, at least one being from an LPBC Alum
  - b. Letters of Recommendation should be no longer than one page each

- 4. Submit a non-refundable application fee as stipulated below, along with contact information.
  - a. Application Fee: \$0 if complete application submitted before February 24th, \$50 February 25th March 24th, \$100 March 25th or after

If I am selected for Leadership Palm Beach County, Inc., then in consideration for permitting me to participate in its programs:

- 1.1 understand my application is only for the Class of 2024 program year. After I apply, if I am unable to participate, no deferral will be granted. If I wish to participate in another year, I must apply again and pay the then current application fee.
- 2.1 will arrive on time for the Overnight Retreat, Orientation, and each session and be in attendance for the full day. I understand that an hour or more counts as an absence, and I can only miss one session day in order to graduate with my class.
- 3.1 will devote the time and necessary resources to complete the Leadership Engage Program and my chosen Engage Forward Project.
- 4.I acknowledge that all tuition fees are due by July 14, 2023, and are NON-REFUNDABLE.
- 5.I have read and understand the class program schedule and my required commitments. I am aware that attendance at the overnight Friday-Saturday Opening Retreat is mandatory.
- 6.I have the authorization of the management of my company/organization for full participation in the Leadership Engage Program.
- 7.I understand that if I attend 8 of the 9 monthly Leadership Engage Program sessions, Orientation, Opening Retreat, and Closing Retreat with my class, or equivalent, I will be eligible to graduate with my class.
- 8.I understand that if I attend 7 of the 9 monthly Leadership Engage Program sessions, Orientation, Opening Retreat, and Closing Retreat, I am still eligible to graduate with my class in June if I participate in a pre-approved and determined Leadership Grow Session day; Not doing so means I may graduate the following year only after making up missed session(s).
