Each year LPBC identifies up to 50 exceptional community leaders to participate in the Leadership Engage program and utilize their leadership abilities for the long-term benefit of Palm Beach County. The selection committee strives to balance the industries, geographic location, and other factors to create a class that is truly representative of the diversity throughout Palm Beach County. While the 50 class members may not work in the same industries, they share the following attributes:

- > A PASSION and personal commitment to help shape the future of Palm Beach County
- > Significant ACHIEVEMENT in career or community
- > An INTEREST in enhancing personal leadership capabilities
- > High standards of PERSONAL INTEGRITY
- > Personal COMMITMENT to educate themselves on community issues and initiatives
- > A DESIRE to support the continuation of leadership development in Palm Beach County

Engage class members aspire to improve our region because they have deepened their civic commitment and awareness of diverse issues and industries. Through the connections, education, and interests developed by our county's most promising leaders, LPBC creates a lasting impact in our community.

Leadership Palm Beach County (LPBC) is a nonprofit organization that brings together leaders from the public, private and nonprofit sectors to build and steward a vibrant, interconnected community.

Since 1983, our unique programs have prepared more than 2,000 adult and youth leaders for a lifetime commitment to doing public good in Palm Beach County.

LPBC's Engage program is based on an interactive, 10-month curriculum that provides leadership capacity-building skills, framed around countywide issues. Participants meet for one day each month, from September to May, and travel the county via bus as they explore program topics such as agriculture, public safety and healthcare. In addition, each participant will take part in a civic engagement project that will solve a challenge in our community while learning to collaborate in a group dynamic with fellow classmates and other leaders. Selection Criteria

LPBC seeks to identify individuals who are most likely to utilize their leadership abilities for the longterm benefit of Palm Beach County. Emphasis is given to those who have demonstrated leadership and community involvement outside of their career, which has long been consistent with graduates' likelihood to continue their involvement beyond graduation. Participants will be selected by an anonymous Selection Committee comprised of LPBC alumni. Committee members will award points for each question, and maximum points are listed for each question. References may be checked. This application is only for the Class of 2020 program year. If a candidate is unable to participate after selected, no deferral will be granted. Applicants who wish to apply again are encouraged to do so, and will need to pay the then current application fee.

Leadership Engage Program Time Commitment



Candidates should only submit an application if certain of their ability to meet the below REQUIRED time commitment.

- > Monthly All-Day Leadership Engage Program Session Days
 (One excused absence allowed, additional missed days must be made up the following year, or through a pre-determined and approved Leadership Grow program day. Missing even one hour will count as an absence.)
- > Opening and Closing Orientation Sessions
- > Friday/Saturday mandatory overnight retreat
- > Civic Engagement participation and meetings as necessary (Average 3-5 hours per month or about 25 hours total outside of class days based on prior projects)

Class of 2020 Engage Program Tuition



Tuition is \$2,300.

If you are selected for the class, the full tuition amount is payable by July 12, 2019.

The tuition includes payment for your first year's dues (\$150) as a member of the Leadership Palm Beach County Alumni Association. You are encouraged to solicit financial backing from your employer or the organization you work or volunteer with, and to pay some portion of the tuition yourself. As we do not believe that tuition should be a barrier to participation, a limited number of partial scholarships are available based on need. While attendance at the overnight retreat in its entirety is mandatory, our policies allow participants to have one excused absence (or portion thereof) from a session day and still graduate with their class. Two or more missed sessions require makeup in the following year to graduate. If participants miss more than four full sessions or the equivalent thereof, they will be dismissed from the class, forfeit all tuition, and reimburse LPBC for any tuition assistance they may have received.

If I am selected for Leadership Palm Beach County, Inc., then in consideration for permitting me to participate in its programs:

- 1. I understand my application is only for the Class of 2020 program year. After I apply, if I am unable to participate, no deferral will be granted. If I wish to participate in another year, I must apply again and pay the then current application fee.
- 2. I will arrive on time for the Overnight Retreat, Orientation, each session and be in attendance for the full day. I understand that an hour or more counts as an absence; and I can only miss one session day in order to graduate with my class in June.
- 3. I will devote the time and necessary resources to complete the Leadership Engage program and my chosen Civic Engagement Project.
- 4. I acknowledge that all tuition fees are due by July 15, 2019 and are NON-REFUNDABLE.
- 5. I have read and understand the class program schedule and my required commitments. I am aware that attendance at Orientation and the overnight Friday-Saturday retreat is mandatory.
- 6. I have the authorization of the management of my company/organization for full participation in the Leadership Engage program.
- 7. I understand that if I attend 8 of the 9 monthly Leadership Engage Program sessions, the Orientation, and Opening Retreat with my class, or equivalent, I will be eligible to graduate with my class.
- 8. I understand that if I attend 7 of the 9 monthly Leadership Engage program sessions, the Orientation Session and the Opening Retreat, I am still eligible to graduate with my class in June if I participate in a preapproved and determined Leadership Grow session day; not doing so means I may graduate the following year only after making up missed session(s).
- 9. I recognize that if I miss more than four (4) full sessions or the equivalent thereof, I will be dismissed from the class and forfeit the full tuition fee, and reimburse LPBC for any tuition assistance I received.
- 10. I understand and support all aspects of Leadership Palm Beach County's mandatory attendance policy as a condition of my acceptance into the program. Leadership Palm Beach County, Inc., shall in no way be liable for any damages I may incur or suffer in the event I am not selected to participate.
